
When I think of World Communion Sunday, I think about the trip I took to Havana, Cuba in January 2018 with my seminary. We visited and worshipped in the churches in the Havana District of the Methodist Church. Our trip fell on the first Sunday in January, so we celebrated Holy Communion at one of the churches that morning. I knew Spanish decently well, but not well enough to be fluent or to know everything being said in worship. However, when it came to Holy Communion, I may not have known all that they were saying in the Great Thanksgiving, but I still recognized and felt the presence of Jesus Christ. We spoke different languages, but we were one in the Spirit. And that is what World Communion Sunday is all about. We are diverse but united at this table of grace. We celebrate Holy Communion together with all Christians around the world and throughout time. What a beautiful, sacred moment in the life of the Church.

Recognizing the significance of bread in the act of Holy Communion, and in the varying types of bread that we have around the world, our October sermon series will focus on Jesus, the Bread of Life. We will journey through John 6, learning what it means that Jesus is the Bread of Life and how that impacts us as we follow Jesus. This series will go beyond Sunday mornings. First, we will have a missional component and do a collection of sandwich bread for the peanut butter and jelly sandwiches we make each week. The bread collection will take place on Sunday, October 26. Second, we will have fun with this series through a Make Your Own Quick Bread class here at Calvary, more details to come.

We will also welcome Rev. Carl Hetler as our guest preacher on Sunday, October 19th, as my family and I will be out of town that weekend during Mishawaka's fall break. Rev. Hetler has preached here before and is the Coordinator for Homeless Outreach for the city of South Bend.

Here's to a fall full of faith, community, and all the pumpkin spice your heart desires.






Life is like that, things happen in our lives that we don't like. We face trials and temptation, but we need to remember that God is not finished with the mixing yet.


Names and photos are needed
