What story do you want your giving to tell? What legacy will we leave for those who come after us?






Traveling Communion



Were you unable to make the quick bread class? You are in luck! Below is the recipe that was shared. A big thank—you to Cherish for spending her evening teaching this class!

Cherish PA's Bread

Bread Ingredients:

2.5 cups sugar 1 cup melted butter

3 tsp. Vanilla 3 Eggs

3 cups flour 3 tsp. Cinnamon

1 tsp. salt 1 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. baking soda

2 cups shredded Zucchini or Apple, or pureed Pumpkin

Preheat oven to 325. Mix above ingredients together. Spray and flour 3-9X5 loaf pans and pour in mix.

Martha's Crumb Topping

3/4 cup flour 1/3 cup brown sugar 3 TBS sugar 6 TBS cold butter

Pinch of salt

Mix above ingredients with your hands until it is sand consistency. Add to the top of your loaves and bake the loaves for 45-55 minutes.
